Summary of Duties:

1. School Engagement

- Prepare and deliver school student engagement activities for local schools and students.
- Develop a trusted and positive rapport with school staff and students across catchment schools.
- Support the coordination and delivery of Uni Hub open days, career expo and industry immersion events, school visits and orientation sessions.
- Promote and support delivery of school-based University and foundation study programs.
- Regularly review and evaluate the effectiveness of school and industry outreach events and activities.

2. Industry Engagement

- Engage with local industry, employers, and major projects across the region to identify areas of unmet skilled and professional workforce shortages, and tertiary education needs that could be supported or delivered through the Uni Hub.
- Facilitate connections between employers and students to establish employment pathways, placement opportunities, and scholarship and cadetship opportunities for students
- Participate in networking events, Uni Hub open days, school visits and wider community and industry engagement initiatives as relevant.
- Establish partnerships with local employers to participate in school engagement activities and career immersion events.

3. Community Engagement

- Build positive relationships with the local Council, Chamber of Commerce, regional development and employment organisations, the local media and other key local and peak bodies.
- Raise positive brand awareness and support various Uni Hub marketing and community engagement initiatives
- Represent Uni Hub as part of community outreach activities across the Eyre Peninsula
